### **General Plan/LCP Update Status**

Ongoing efforts and upcoming tasks in the next quarter are described below for the General Plan/LCP Update.

#### *Existing Elements*

The Wood team (formerly Amec Foster Wheeler) is updating the Design Element and the Public Facilities & Services Element. Updates are focused on strengthening language, ensuring policies are enforceable, and consolidating redundant policies. The updated Design Element and Public Facilities & Services Element will be presented at future General Plan Committee meetings (dates TBD).

#### *Sea Level Rise & Adaptation Planning*

The California Coastal Commission reviewed the Administrative Draft Sea Level Rise Vulnerability Assessment report. The Wood team including subconsultant Revell

Coastal integrated Coastal Commission comments and produced the Draft Coastal Vulnerability and Adaptation Project report. The Draft Coastal Vulnerability and Adaptation Project report is available for public review and comment from July 9, 2018 to August 3, 2018.

A public workshop on sea level rise vulnerability and adaptation planning will be held at the Carpinteria Children's Project auditorium on Tuesday, July 31<sup>st</sup> 2018 from 4:30pm – 6:30pm. The public will have an opportunity to provide input on which assets they think are most important to protect from sea level rise in the City.

#### *Caltrans Transportation Planning Grant*

The kickoff meeting between Caltrans, the City of Carpinteria, and the Wood team was held on June 6, 2018. The Wood team has begun drafting the Existing Conditions Report, Environmental Justice Technical Study, and Transportation Infrastructure Technical Study under the grant program.

#### **Project Schedule**

The California Coastal Commission approved of an amendment to the LCP grant schedule. The amended schedule is included in Attachment C.

1. Call to Order: 5:30 pm
2. Roll Call: Clark, Stein, Allen, and Callender present
3. Sea Level Rise Vulnerability Presentation: Dave Revell of Revell Coastal provided a presentation of key findings from the Carpinteria sea level rise vulnerability assessment.
4. Committee Comments: The committee provided comments on the Carpinteria sea level rise vulnerability assessment.
  - Callender – *Inquired about fluvial flooding risks and the Carpinteria Salt Marsh sediment basin.*
  - Allen – *Stated that fluvial risks are important in all parts of the General Plan and natural disasters.*
  - Clark – *Inquired about the H++ scenario and how sea level rise is measured.*
5. Public Comments: The floor was open to attendees from the community to provide comments on the Carpinteria sea level rise vulnerability assessment.
  - Mike Wondolowski – *Inquired about the risks to the Carpinteria Bluffs, coastal erosion, and potential opportunities.*
  - Jones – *Inquired about the planning horizons and impacts to the highway.*
  - Committee Member Clark – *Responded that the US Highway 101 HOV EIR has a sea level rise impact mitigation measure to make a viaduct.*
  - Terry Wheeler – *Commented on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Street pedestrian underpass proposal at Holly Avenue and Holly Avenue exit.*
  - Mike Wondolowski – *Inquired about economic impact quantification. Stated that sea walls are fundamentally inconsistent with Carpinteria's character. Noted that property values would be affected by loss of beach.*
  - Committee Member Callender – *Stated that has been pushing the City to do more work on sea level rise and it is invaluable in decision-making. Would like*

*the flow of information to be more of an open process. Worries that people will dismiss high probability.*
