Project Background

The Carpinteria Avenue Bridge over Carpinteria Creek was originally built in 1937. The bridge is nearing the end of its useful life, and Caltrans has deemed it structurally deficient.

The City of Carpinteria is working on designs for a new bridge that will meet current earthquake and vehicular safety standards. To add neighborhood benefits, the City has requested that the design include:

- wider sidewalks on the bridge
- improved water flow under the bridge to reduce the risk of flooding
- enhanced bike access over the bridge
- creek bed and bank enhancements

Construction Staging

During construction, the City of Carpinteria aims to keep one lane open in each direction on Carpinteria Avenue to maintain access for residents, businesses, and tourists.

The new bridge will be constructed one side at a time to allow for traffic flow. Construction is anticipated to last approximately 2 years.

Our goal is to keep surrounding driveways and local streets open during construction. There may be temporary closures and/or alternating lane closures as needed.

Design and Approval Process

The City of Carpinteria is currently in the environmental review process.

The bridge will be reviewed by the City's Architectural Review Board, the Planning Commission, and the City Council. Each hearing will be open to the public and held at the City of Carpinteria.

Bridge construction is expected to begin in spring 2018 and likely take two years to complete depending on the final design chosen.
