I. BACKGROUND:

Business Partner Award Program

The City's Outstanding Business Partner Award Program recognizes local businesses, large and small, that give back to the community. Contributions to the community from prior Business Partners include contributions to local schools, donations to non-profit organizations which support community causes, etc. The award recipients are recognized in the City Hall newsletter and by the City Council as they are presented with an Outstanding Business Partner certificate at a City Council meeting. Since the program began in 1997, the City has honored 41 businesses.

Summer 2011 Award Recipient—Carpinteria Glass Company

Carpinteria Glass Company has been selected as the City's Summer 2011 Outstanding Business Partner Award Recipient. It has been located in Carpinteria since the early 1950s and is currently located at 4188 Carpinteria Avenue, Unit #1. Philip and Cecilia Barton-Grimley have owned the business since 1983 where they sell, install, and maintain a variety of residential and commercial glass products and applications.

Both Philip and Cecilia have an active role in the business. Philip is a Journeyman glazer. He is primarily responsible for sales, quotes, and the installation and maintenance of various glass related products.
