**A RESOLUTION OF THE CARPINTERIA CITY COUNCIL
COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING
KARINA JOUGLA UPON BEING NAMED
JUNIOR CARPINTERIAN OF THE YEAR FOR 2011**

WHEREAS, each year the Carpinteria Valley Chamber of Commerce selects and honors a student as Junior Carpinterian of the Year in recognition of her academic and personal accomplishments, and

WHEREAS, on January 28, 2012, the Chamber announced the selection of Karina Jouglu as Junior Carpinterian of the Year for 2011 and as recipient of a \$4,000 college scholarship in recognition of her many achievements; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Jouglu has won the Carpinteria Women's Club, '2008 Outstanding Young Woman Award,' the Kiwanis Club 'Youth of the Month Award' in both October 2008 and December 2010, has received the 'President's Education Award for Outstanding Academic Excellence' for the past three years, received the Carpinteria Masonic Lodge 'Science Student of the Month' in 2011, is a 'National Merit Scholarship Semi-Finalist' and earned the 'James Otis Lecture Essay Contest' awarded by the local chapter of the American Board of Trial Advocates; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Jouglu has been an active member of Junior State of America since her freshman year, serves on the Youth Advisory Board for Congress member Lois Capps, has served as the national representative on "Girl Up Teen Advisors" and as a theater ensemble coach at Girls Inc. She has participated in the JASON Project, a National Geographic and Sea Research Foundation, which develops interactive science curriculum, participated as a French international exchange student in July 2010 and in August 2011, sings in the Carpinteria High School Vocal Ensemble, has played on the high school tennis team for three years, was a School Site Council representative, and has been a member in good standing of the California Scholarship Federation; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Jouglu has completed many more than the required community service hours by volunteering for the Girls Inc. Drama Camp, at Kinderkirk Preschool, as a docent for the Carpinteria Seal Watch and with the Carpinteria Middle School Ocean Guards Club, plus she has maintained a 4.35 GPA throughout high school and ranks eighth in the current Carpinteria High School Graduating class of 167 students; and
